- Sidney Rigdon - (A*)

Born 19 Feb 1793 in St. Clair, Penn., baptized 4 Nov 1830 by Oliver Cowdery in Kirtland, ordained a High Priest 3 June 1831 by Lyman Wight, 1st counselor to Joseph Smith on 18 Mar 1833, experienced many heavenly manifestations, poor health following the beating and tar and feathering he experienced with Joseph in Hiram, endured much persecution in Missouri and Nauvoo, Nauvoo City Council, city attorney, postmaster. Was Joseph's running mate in Joseph's candidacy for the President of the U.S. Excommunicated 8 Sep 1844. Sidney left Nauvoo and formed a church (Church of Christ) in Penn. Later he founded the "Church of Jesus Christ of the Children of Zion". He lived out his days in Friendship, NY and died 14 Jul 1876. Organized the Campbellite church.

Jacob Scott - (A!) -

Born 12 Aug 1782, Died 2 Jan 1845 Nauvoo, Baptized 22 Mar 1837. Ordained a <u>High Priest 6 Jun 1831, was called on a mission one day later</u> (D&C 52:28). Jacob <u>apostatized after receiving the call and refused to go</u>. Joined with other apostates, <u>manifested a greater spirit of persecution</u> than any other enemy.

→ Hyrum Smith - (F) 💥

<u>A witness to the Book of Mormon</u>. Born 9 Feb 1800 in Tunbridge, VT, baptized 29 June 1829 by Joseph Smith in Seneca Lake, NY, ordained a High Priest 3 June 1831 by Joseph Smith, assistant president of the high priesthood 3 Sep 1837, 2nd counselor in 1st Pres. 7 Nov 1837 (following Frederick G. Williams), given all priesthood held by Oliver Cowdery including Apostle, ordained a Patriarch on 24 Jan 1841. Remained faithful his entire life and died as a martyr with his brother Joseph Smith.

Joseph Smith, Jr. - (F)

Born 23 Dec 1805, Died 27 Jun 1844. Was the prophet of the restoration. Translated the Book of Mormon. The central figure in the re-establishment of the Church and Kingdom on the earth in this dispensation. Organized the Church. Gave his life for the testimony of Jesus Christ that was his.

Joseph Smith Sr. - (F)

A with the work of Mormon. Born 12 Ju11771 in Topsfield, Mass., baptized 6 Apr 1830 and Smith Jr. in Fayette, NY, ordained a High Priest on 3 Jun 1831 by Lyman Wight, and Retriarch to the church 18 Dec 1833, assistant counselor to the 1st Presidence (See 1837. Always faithful.
